A2SO4's summer internship program provides exceptional architecture and interior design students with opportunities to gain professional experience at our headquarters in Indianapolis.

In 2010, A2SO4 will be offering two internship positions — one for 3rd year or above architecture students and one for 3rd year interior design students. These internships will be a unique opportunity to blend the practical and the imaginative potential that both architecture and interior design offer. You will work with a talented team of dedicated and innovative staff, who have designed world-class projects.

ARCHITECTURE SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAM OFFERS THREE MONTHS OF TRAINING FROM MID-MAY UNTIL MID-AUGUST

This internship provides opportunities for the student to explore the practical and conceptual in scope. You will work collaboratively with principals, directors, and designers on large- and small-scale projects. As part of your training, you will be involved in the construction document process, schematic design, client meetings, research, design charrettes, and construction site visits.

During your internship, you will be required to test your design intelligence by investigating a specific design problem. You will spend one third of your time working within A2SX, an A2SO4 initiative, is a collaborative space exploring digital fabrication, research, and design. You will be investigating, researching, designing, and prototyping as a way to not only enhance your training and skills, but as an exercise to familiarize yourself with budgets, contractors, local fabricators, and representation. Previous interns have worked collaboratively to design objects such as handbags, screens, chairs, and installations.

The top 5 qualifying students will be contacted for interviews by Monday, April 19th.

1. A well written cover letter
2. A letter of recommendation
3. A well designed resume that includes GPA and studio grades
4. Samples of your work
 - a. Samples of no more than 6 projects
 - b. 4 samples/photographs of your work done by hand ie: (sketches, models, prototypes)
 - c. Samples/photographs of built work, installations, furniture, or objects

Electronic samples should be presented in a pdf format not to exceed 10 MB and emailed to wmarquez@a2so4.com. Printed samples no larger than 11 x 17 should be mailed to the address below. Please do not send any originals as A2SO4 will not be responsible for returning work.
